## Support Thriving Youth Fund

Helping youth achieve their maximim potential grows healthy, thriving communities.

### What This Bill Does

- Creates an income tax checkoff for the Thriving Youth Income Tax Checkoff Fund to allow Illinoisans to donate to support community-based youth programs.
- Provides that moneys in the Fund shall be used by the Department of Human Services for the purpose of making grants to providers delivering non-Medicaid services for community-based youth programs in the State.
- Creates a fund that supports DHS programs — such as TeenREACH, Redeploy Illinois, Homeless Youth, Comprehensive Community-Based Youth Services — intended to support young people within their communities.

### What This Bill Does NOT Do

Does not establish a new tax. Donating is completely voluntary.
