CLARIFICATION: [After School Programs Grant](#)

The [Illinois State Board of Education](#) has released the After School Programs Grant. The purpose of this funding opportunity is to establish and sustain high-quality after-school programs for students across the state of Illinois. This Request for Proposals (RPF) is specifically for community-based organizations (CBOs) and totals \$3 million. **Proposals must be submitted no later than November 14, 2022, at 4:00 p.m.**

[Expanded Mental Health Services Grant](#)

On **October 3, 2022**, the [U.S Department of Education](#) released two grants centered around mental health. [School-Based Mental Health Services \(SBMH\)](#) provides funding to schools to increase the number of credentialed school-based mental health professionals. The second program, the [Mental Health Service Professional Demonstration \(MHSP\) grants](#), support districts in hiring additional school-based mental health service providers in high-need districts by boosting the mental health profession pipeline. There is a technical assistance [webinar](#) **TODAY** on **October 18, 2022**. The deadline for submitting applications is **November 3, 2022**.
