

## **Policy**

#### FY19 Budget Signed into Law

On June 4th, Governor Rauner signed the FY19 budget into law. The plan is the first full-year budget enacted since he took office in 2015. It maintains state government spending, increases funding for K-12 education, and includes \$13.8 million for Teen REACH. #### Children's Cabinet Update

On June 7, 2018, the Governor's Cabinet on Children and Youth met in Chicago. The Cabinet received updates on its projects. The multi-system involved youth project will focus on inter-agency collaboration to solve problems identified by youth. The mentoring project will consist of a mentoring scan, toolkit, and matching process. Parts of the transitional math and high school equivalency project are expected to be adopted by ISBE next week. The CCAP research project has hit some obstacles due to legal and procurement issues. You can find details and materials from the meeting here.
